7. Note that there is a search function. To find the APEN group type in 'Australian Psychology Educators Network' (as APEN is less than the 5 letter minimum search). This is faster than going into 'people and groups' as this contains lists of every group across all disciplines, including psychology. Alternatively 'psychology' can be typed in, and one of the groups that will appear is APEN.
